

About this fund



This fund is to support students from Flintshire, Denbighshire and Conwy County.



It is for students finding it hard to pay for things. They will be studying Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics. Or a course that includes a lot of science related topics.

How much can you apply for?



You can apply for up to £1000 a year, for up to 4 years.



These types of courses are covered:

- Undergraduate level courses
- Postgraduate level courses
- HND courses
- PhD courses.



Students applying for postgraduate study must tell us about what they will study. And their research.



Students will get further funding each year of their course if a report is completed.



Grants are for specific courses. If they are for something else, you must ask permission first.

Who can apply?



• People living in Flintshire, Denbighshire or Conwy county.



• They must be under 25 years of age.



• They must show they need the support.



This fund can cover costs to do with the course. For example, equipment, exams and other things.



Students should have proof of being on the course.

How to apply



You must fill out an online application form. You can get this on our website:

Important things to know:



 We cannot pay for anything that has happened before:



- We send you an offer letter.



 You send us a signed copy of the terms and conditions.



• We will need up to date information about the course and deadlines.



• If you are applying for a postgraduate course, you must have a 1st class degree, or an upper 2nd class degree.



• You must tell us about any changes. For example, exam failure or health issues.



• Students are more likely to get the fund if they show how they meet its goals. And show they need the fund.
